LET'S CHAT

Discuss with your child the love the father has for the baby and what he would have felt like if he hadn't seen him again. Also talk about the importance of the baby to the Dad. He may have been small but he was very important to the Dad.

Talk with your children about how Jairus was feeling about his daughter being sick, dead and then healed! Use the emotions props to help you.
